



“Our Family Context & God’s Story”

A 4-part series into the Life of Joseph exploring how God works within our immediate context to form and shape us so that we might know His love, grace, and mercy and be used for His kingdom purpose.

Discussion Questions:

- What part of Joseph’s family story do you resonate with the most? What is your family dynamic like?
- Do you see the hand of God in your family life? (Please explain your answer.)
- How have you prayed for your family? How can you pray for your family in the future?
