Video Summary of Part 1:

Finishing the Task exists to convene and to catalyze the global body of Christ towards the goal of ensuring that everyone, everywhere has access to a Bible, Believer and Body of Christ.

How are we going to complete the Great Commission in our generation?

- 1. Mobilize the allies and let them fly their own flags
- 2. Simple and clear goal: 3 Bs (Bible, Believer, Body of Christ) in every UUPG and unreached place
- 3. Finish the task by AD 2033.
- 4. Increase numbers of allies and diversify
- 5. Decentralize by giving power to the lowest level
- 6. Focus on people in pain the most
- 7. Sense of urgency.

- 1. Why hasn't the Great Commissions already been accomplished?

- 4. How are we going to mobilize all people to be involved in finishing the task and giving them ownership?
- 5. When finishing the task becomes challenging and we want to give up, how are we going to continue being motivated?
- 6. What role are you going to take in finishing the task?

Video Summary of Part 1:

1. We must speed up the task of Bible translation

2. We must use every available channel to spread the Gospel

a. Saturation Evangelism: Using every available MEANS to reach every available PERSON at every available TIME

- 3. We must start all kinds of churches to reach all kinds of people
 - a. Rabbit church: micro in size (house church), strength: simplicity, fast reproductivity
 - b. Tiger church: mid-size (75-200 people), strength: fellowship, slower reproductivity
 - c. Elephant church mega in size (over 2,000 people), strength: full service, really slow reproductive speed
 - d. None these churches have to have a building
 - e. A mother church doesn't have to be big to have babies

Instructions: Watch the video from the beginning and stop at the 24:00 time marker. Split into groups of 3-4 and answer the discussion questions below.

- 1. How are we going to finish the task of bringing the gospel to the nations?
- 2. How can you spread the gospel seeds to the most receptive people?
 - a. Name someone you want to share the gospel with.
 - b. How can you bring the gospel to that person in his/her culture and context?
- 3. How can you focus on people in pain? Is there someone in your life who's facing pain?
 - a. If so, how can you reach out and comfort that person?
 - b. If not, how can you make yourself available to reach out to people in pain?
- 4. From the three different types of churches, which one stands out to you and why?
- 5. Is your church a mature and reproductive church?
 - a. If so, how is your church being a mature and reproductive church?
 - b. If not, what steps do your church need to take in order to be a mature and reproductive church?

1. We must mobilize all kinds of people to plant all kinds of churches and we must partner together.

- 2. We must unite around the Great Commandment and Great Commission
 - a. Love God with all your heart...Churches that worship
 - b. Love your neighbor...Churches that minister
 - c. Go make disciples...Churches that evangelize
 - d. Baptize them...Churches that fellowship
 - e. Teach them to do...Churches that disciple
- 3. We must empower every believer to be an ambassador for Christ
- 4. We must organize people to pray for the Great Commission
 - a. Because we are in a spiritual battle
 - b. Because it's the key to God's power
 - c. Because Jesus commanded us to pray for more workers
