## How to start making and multiplying disciples? (Part 1: Finding and engaging persons of peace)

## Purpose:

This workshop gives participants an overview of the DMM process and train participants in the 2 main strategies and field-tested tools of finding and engaging persons of peace.

## Outline:

- 1. What does the process of making and multiplying disciples look like?
  - a. Diagram: the 4 Stages of Making and Multiplying disciples
  - b. Knowing the objectives and essential steps of each stage
- 2. Stage 1: Finding persons of peace and helping them become disciples and disciple-makers.
  - a. What are the characteristics of a person of peace?
  - b. The 2 main strategies of finding and engaging POP's:
    - i. The first strategy is through personal relational network (oikos)
      - 1. 5 week disciple making challenge
      - 2. The Oikos map
      - 3. 30 day prayer calendar
      - 4. Invitation to a DBS
      - 5. Real-life examples: Frankie & Nathan
    - ii. The second strategy is by going into an open harvest field—pockets or community of people with needs and struggles
      - 1. Example 1: Los Angeles homeless and grassroot community (Anna)
      - 2. Example 2: Syrian refugees in Lebanon
      - 3. Open worship and prayer
      - 4. Prayer walk

- 5. Understanding their needs and find ways to introduce Jesus to them
- 6. Prayer and power evangelism
- c. How to start a spiritual conversation?
  - i. The 4 conversation quadrants
  - ii. Asking questions
- d. How to help people experience Jesus
  - i. Prayer and power evangelism
  - ii. Sharing personal testimonies
  - iii. Sharing stories of Jesus
  - iv. Ask what they want to change in their lives or hearts
  - v. Invite them to a DBS
