Video Time: Principles #2 & 3: 20 minutes, Part 2 of 3

Video Summary: Principle #2: **Go** to people with **needs & problems** to **love on them** and help them **experience God's love & power**.

Principle #3: Make **PRAYER** your **#1 priority**. Pray for a **multiplication** of fellow **disciple-makers** and **new trainees**.

Instructions: Watch the video from 21:47 and end at 41:40. Split into groups of 3-4 and answer the discussion questions below.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. How did Jesus start a movement? Read Matthew 9:35-38.
2. Where can you go to find the people with needs and problems to love on them and help them experience God's love and power?
3. Name a person who needs to experience God's love and power and who God is putting on your heart to reach out to. This could be people in your community, co-worker, friends, family, neighbor, etc. How does this person need to experience God's love and power?
4. How can you get out of your comfort zone to reach out to those people?
5. Pray together in pairs for the person that you named in question #3. Pray for each other to have the courage to get out of your comfort zone to reach out to that person.
6. How can you start to pray and make it a priority?
7. What can you do to love your neighbors, co-worker, family, and friends?
8. Pray together in pairs for the following:
 - a. God would open up doors for people to reach out to.
 - b. Make prayer a priority.
 - c. God will lead you to the person of peace
 - d. Multiplication of disciple maker.

2. What are the strategic principles that Jesus wanted his disciples to adhere to?
3. Why is relationship evangelism not the way to approach the disciple making movements?
4. How do you find the right person or the person of peace?
5. Let's look at two different examples of a person of peace:
 - a. Read Luke 5:27-29 about Levi the tax collector. What characteristics do Levi have as a person of peace?
 - b. Read John 4:17-29 about the Samaritan woman at the well. What characteristics do the Samaritan woman have as a person of peace?
6. What are other characteristics of a person of peace?
7. From the characteristics of the person of peace, who is the person of peace in your life who's open and hungry for God?
8. What is one takeaway from what you learned about DMM?
9. What action do you want to take after learning about the 4 principles of DMM?
